

Her mission is to provide high quality spays, neuters, vaccinations, dentals, micro-chipping, routine blood tests and fecal testing at the lowest possible cost. She and her volunteer staff proudly partner with over 100 different licensed dog and cat rescues from Florida to Maine to help maintain the health of their adoptable pets. This is an incredible impact for the animal community saving lives and saving monetary resources. By providing low-cost spay and neuters she completes all the necessary vaccines and health certifications so that homeless animals can travel via transport with the proper health certificates to other states where adoptive families are awaiting. Doc T and her team donate their time and medical expertise. They charge other rescues only a fraction above wholesale cost of medicines and vaccines, providing a significant savings to these organizations.




Any profit the clinic makes is donated directly back to Noah's Ark to help provide care for the 1,500 permanent residents that call the Ark their forever home.




New Signage Allows Easier Navigation and Interaction With Our Residents

While exploring, learn more about our residents by turning on your camera app and scanning the new QR code signs by each habitat.


This is the first phase of many to create a more engaging, educational and interactive experience for our guests. Keep an eye out for our new educational and awareness signs coming soon!
