At Noah's Ark Animal Sanctuary, we are deeply committed to this cause, especially considering the backgrounds of our own tigers who were rescued from the cub petting industry.

The United States has taken significant steps to combat the exploitation of big cats with the Big Cat Public Safety Act of 2022. This crucial legislation aims to end private possession of big cats as pets and curtail the inhumane practices associated with cub petting.

Our tigers, like many others, suffered in conditions not meant for wild animals. By providing them with a safe, respectful, and natural environment, we uphold strict ethical standards: no petting, no breeding, and a lifelong commitment to their well-being.
