Coming Soon To Noah's Ark

At Noah's Ark, we believe every animal deserves a space where they can thrive—and our beloved group (AKA creep) of African Spur-Thighed Tortoises (Sulcatas) is no exception.

Like many Sulcatas in captivity, these gentle giants started life as pets. With good intentions, their former owners brought home adorable, silver-dollar-sized hatchlings, unaware of the tremendous size and care these animals require. Now, grown to the size of the third-largest tortoise species in the world, they've found their forever home with us—and we want to give them the space they truly deserve.

Introducing 'Tortoise Bluff':

We're excited to create a naturalistic area where our Sulcatas can roam, dig tunnels, and soak up the sun just as they would in the wild. Visitors will enjoy meandering paths that provide views of these incredible animals from every angle. This exhibit will also include upgraded housing for our African crested porcupines, an 'enrichment' grove, plus an educational space for our Jr. Keeper program and other learning opportunities.

Our Plan:

We have 3 phases of this project:

Phase 1: Build a new home for our Sulcata group with a newly fenced yard, night house, and guest walkway. (\$5,500)

Phase 2: Add landscape, an edible 'enrichment grove' for both tortoises and other residents to enjoy, and build an upgraded space for our porcupines—who were rescued from an animal auction. (\$5,000)

Phase 3: Create housing for smaller tortoise species and an 'education station' for our Jr. Keeper and Scout programs. (\$3,000)



We've already started Phase 1, but need your help to keep the momentum going.



Phase 2 will include providing a bigger space for our African crested porcupines and adding an 'enrichment grove' with edible plants for our residents.
