


## Where second chances and new beginnings are made.



#### **Tortoise Bluff is Back on Track!**


With the fox rescue requiring urgent attention, our **Tortoise Bluff project** was briefly

paused. Now, we're ramping up efforts to complete **a brand-new home for our giant tortoises and African crested porcupines**. Many of the materials we had hoped to repurpose were used in the fox enclosures, leaving us **\$1,500 short** to complete their insulated shelter and keep Phase 1 and 2 of the project moving forward.
